*We will be staying slope-side in the medieval Italian village of **Bormio** which is secluded in the **Rhaetian Alps**, near the Swiss and Austrian borders. Bormio was the host of the Alpine Ski World Championship in 2005. Bormio's ancient cobblestone streets give the town's pedestrian zone a truly authentic Italian charm and those searching for an abundance of nightlife will have no trouble finding it here.*

Go for a Soak; Master The Spa

*Bormio's origins are inextricably linked to its thermal waters, which have been renowned for their curative powers since ancient times. The nine hot springs are mentioned in Roman documents dating back to the first century AD. The **Bagni Vecchi** (Old Baths) were visited by Leonardo da Vinci in 1494 and were the holiday resort of the Imperial Court of Austria. The indoor/outdoor spa facilities are less than 2 miles from the center of Bormio and include hot waterfalls, aromatic saunas, alfresco mud baths, thermal pools and a 164-foot-long warm-water cave tunnel.*
